



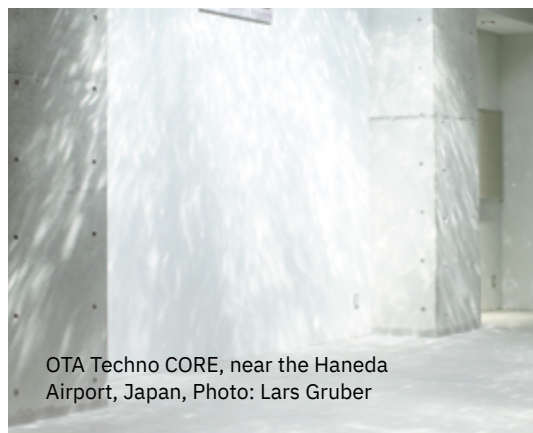
Lighting

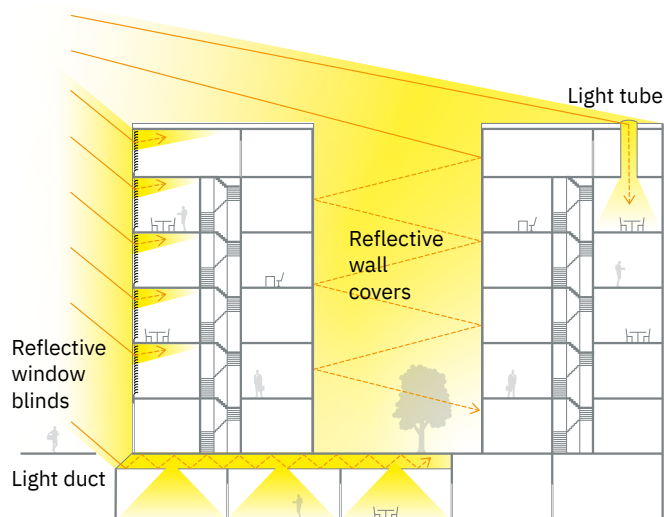
